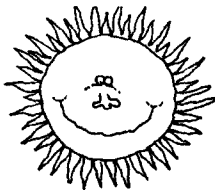

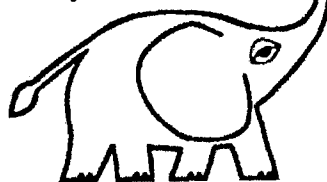

Volunteers from CBC will travel to Maine again this summer for a one-week mission trip. We will return to Winthrop and work through Camp Mechuwana August 1-7.

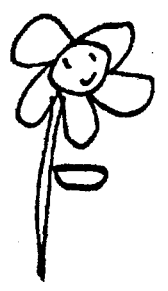
Our projects may include repairing homes for low-income families; working in a local food bank; and doing construction and repairs at the camp, which serves children near or below the poverty line.


The trip will be open to students who will be in high school in

Brochures with more information about the mission trip are available in the church parlor.

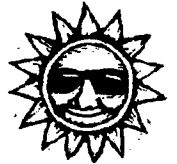
